






TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS 25 °C, unless otherwise noted







TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS 25 °C, unless otherwise noted




Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage




Threshold Voltage Variance Over Temperature



On-Resistance vs. Gate-Source Voltage




Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient


Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Foot




- · The characteristics shown in the two graphs
 - Normalized Transient Thermal Impedance Junction-to-Ambient (25 °C)
 - Normalized Transient Thermal Impedance Junction-to-Foot (25 °C) are given for general guidelines only to enable the user to get a "ball park" indication of part capabilities. The data are extracted from single pulse transient thermal impedance characteristics which are developed from empirical measurements. The latter is valid for the part mounted on printed circuit board FR4, size 1" x 1" x 0.062", double sided with 2 oz. copper, 100 % on both sides. The part capabilities can widely vary depending on actual application parameters and operating conditions.


