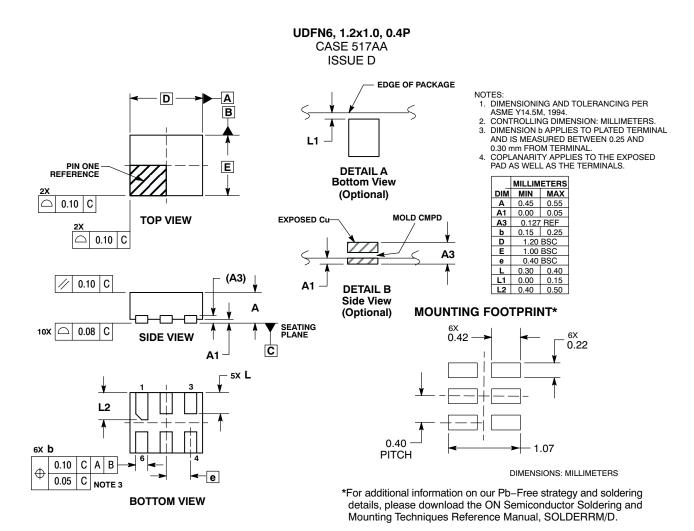
#### Figure 4. Test Circuit

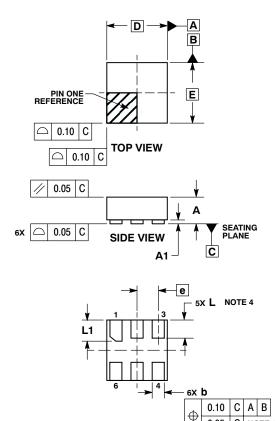
# RECOMMENDED SOLDERING FOOTPRINT\*

**BOTTOM VIEW** 

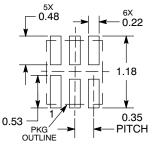

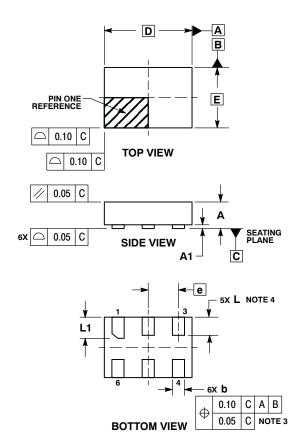
MOUNTING FOOTPRINT SOLDERMASK DEFINED\*

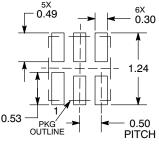
